### Role and Functions of the Anti-Ragging Committee & Squads

The Committee shall perform the following functions in accordance with AICTE/UGC norms:

- To prevent any act of ragging, whether verbal, written, physical, or psychological, against freshers or any student.
- To prohibit rowdy or in disciplined behavior causing annoyance, hardship, fear, or harm.
- To prevent forcing students to perform acts leading to shame, embarrassment, or mental trauma.
- To monitor and prevent disruption of academic activities by senior students.
- To prohibit financial extortion, exploitation, or forced services.
- To prevent physical, sexual, or verbal abuse, including cyber-ragging.
- To safeguard the mental health, dignity, and self-confidence of all students.
- To conduct awareness programmes and ensure zero-tolerance towards ragging.

All students are strictly warned that ragging is a punishable offence, and any violation shall attract strict disciplinary action as per AICTE/UGC regulations and applicable laws.

This order shall remain effective for the Academic Session 2025-26 or until further orders.
